INSTRUCTIONS TO CIRCULATORS

PLEASE READ CAREFULLY!!

- 1. You cannot sign your own petition. However, you can sign another circulator's.
- 2. Each person can sign the petition only once.
- 3. You cannot leave a petition lying in a public place to be signed. Each signature must be obtained in your presence and witnessed by you.
- 4. Once you have started to circulate a petition, you cannot give that copy to another person to finish circulating. This is because all signatures on the petition must be witnessed by the same circulator who signs and notarizes it. If you have a petition only partly filled, please sign it before a notary and return it to StopThief with the signatures you have on it.
- 5. Please ask people to write or print legibly and include their mailing address and ZIP Code. 99% of signers will cooperate with this request.
- 6. If someone else takes over from you at a booth, they should bring their own copy of the petition, not get signatures on your copy.
- 7. Each copy of the petition MUST be signed by the circulator IN FRONT OF A NOTARY PUBLIC. This is a legal document, and by signing before a notary, you are witnessing the signatures and declaring under oath that they were obtained in your presence.
- 8. The signed and notarized petitions should be returned to: Norman C. (Clint) Cooper, 4848 Highway 85, Lot 119, Williston, ND 58801-8612. It is of the greatest importance to get the petitions into Clint's hands BEFORE JULY 13 – any he doesn't turn in to the Secretary of State by that date are useless!!
